Code of Behaviour

1. In the event of bad behaviour the young person will, in the first instance, receive a verbal warning from the leader.
2. If the young person's behaviour does not improve then they will be removed from the activity in which they are participating for a fixed period of time agreed by the leaders. During this time they will be encouraged to "reflect upon" and "redeem" their behaviour.
3. If the young person continues to misbehave the leader will phone their parent/carer and agree on the next course of action.
